Assistant Professorship in Sociology of European Societies (W-1)

starting at October 01, 2018.

We are looking for candidates with research expertise and teaching experience in one or more of the following areas:

- Social Structure
- Political Sociology
- Sociology of Culture
- Economic Sociology
- Sociology of the Welfare State

The ideal candidate combines a background in Comparative Sociology with expertise in researching supranational and transnational processes, with an emphasis on quantitative methods.

Qualifications:

- A doctorate (ideally, „summa cum laude“) in Sociology or Social Sciences
- Demonstrated excellence or the potential for excellence in research (a strong publication record, including publications in English; ideally, initial success in attracting third-party funding)
- Teaching experience in the field

Duties:

- Teaching undergraduate and graduate courses (in German and English), e.g. within the programs Social Sciences (BA/MA) and European Studies (BA/MA)
- Teaching load: two courses per term (4 SWS); after successful evaluation, three courses per term (6 SWS)
- Readiness to apply for third-party research funding and to engage in interdisciplinary research projects
- Participation in academic and administrative activities and duties

Formal prerequisites for the appointment of Assistant Professors are stated in § 40 HSG LSA, the limitation in § 41 (1) HSG LSA.

Applications from disabled persons will be given priority in the case of equal suitability, ability and professional expertise. The Otto von Guericke University aims to increase the proportion of women researchers within the university and specifically encourages women to apply.
