The Otto von Guericke University Magdeburg (OVGU) is an internationally oriented and regionally networked university with a strong research profile.

The Faculty of Economics and Management at the Otto von Guericke University Magdeburg (Germany) invites applications for a

Junior Professorship (W1) in Behavioral Accounting

to begin as soon as possible.

Founded in 1993, the faculty is one of the youngest of its kind in Germany. It offers a variety of programs in Economics and Management on bachelor and master level and also provides service courses to students throughout the broader university community. Language of instruction is either German or English depending on the program. Recent rankings reflect the faculty's growing recognition as a high quality research institution.

Elaborating on that, we seek candidates who have a doctorate in accounting and are committed to excellence in research. A research program that focuses on high quality journals is preferred. We are particularly interested in candidates who conduct research in the field of managerial accounting focussing on sociological and psychological influences and effects of incentive contracts and information systems. Methodologically, candidates should be experienced in both analytical and experimental research. Formally, the Junior Professorship is orientated towards the faculty's research cluster of decision design emphasizing accounting content.

The successful candidate receives a three-year contract to start as soon as possible with a teaching load of 4 hours per week. Upon positive evaluation, the contract shall be prolonged for another three-year period. The salary corresponds to the W1 level of the German University scale.

Selection for this position will be based on academic qualification. Formal prerequisites for the appointment are qualifications according to § 40 of the Higher Education Act for the Federal State of Saxony-Anhalt (HSG LSA).

Applications from disabled persons will be given priority in the case of equal suitability, ability and professional expertise. The Otto von Guericke University aims to increase the proportion of women researchers within the university and specifically encourages women to apply.
