

The Medical Faculty of Otto-von-Guericke-University Magdeburg, Germany invites applications for a

**W3-Professorship of Neurology**  
(Successor Univ.- Prof. Dr. med. H.-J. Heinze)

starting at the earliest possible date.

The candidate should represent the field of research, teaching and health care across the board. The chair of the Department of Neurology is linked to the professorship. The clinic is part of the scientific center of Neurosciences with Multimodal Imaging, Neuroradiology, Neurosurgery, Stereotactic Neurosurgery and Neuropathology. The neuroscientific focus is on close scientific collaboration with the German Center for Neurodegenerative Diseases and the Leibniz Institute for Neurobiology. An intensive clinical and scientific interdisciplinary cooperation with the neighboring subjects and institutes is expected from the applicant.

In addition to a high degree of commitment in teaching and excellent clinical skills in the above-mentioned areas, an excellent scientific qualification with national and international visibility is required. The jobseeker's research profile is expected to complement the scientific priorities available at the Faculty of Medicine (neuroscience and immunology, including Molecular Medicine of Inflammation).

The professorship-related tasks of the management of the clinic including the associated liquidation law are governed by a chief physician contract.

In the contract, the tasks associated with the management of the clinic, including the treatment of private patients, are assigned to the service tasks. The current liquidation law will be replaced by performance-based compensation. This can be waived if a professor has already been liquidated.

The Otto-von-Guericke University aims to increase the proportion of women at all stages of the academic career and therefore urges female scientists to apply.

Applications of severely handicapped people will be given preferential treatment if they are of the same suitability, aptitude and professional qualification.
