The Otto von Guericke University Magdeburg (OVGU) is an internationally oriented and regionally networked university with a strong research profile.

The Faculty of Process and Systems Engineering at the Otto von Guericke University Magdeburg (OVGU) invites applications for the position of a

Professorship (W3) in Chemical Process Engineering

to begin in April 1, 2022.

The future holder (m/f/d) of this position shall represent and advance the scientific field of Chemical Process Engineering in research and teaching. The faculty expects candidates with an excellent research record as well as substantial experience in teaching and in the acquisition of funded projects.

Networking capabilities within the university and to other research institutions are expected, as well as active participation in the academic self-administration at OVGU. The position holder is expected to make significant contributions to the topical research foci of the faculty and to participate in inter-faculty research areas and collaborations. The candidate's own research interests should be in hot-topics regarding chemical reaction engineering or chemical process engineering. A meaningful concept with concrete ideas for the cooperation with the chairs of the Faculty for Process and Systems Engineering and the neighboring faculties of the Otto von Guericke University is expected as part of the application.

The Faculty of Process and Systems Engineering attaches great importance to the quality of teaching and supervision of students. In addition to continuing to teach compulsory courses in Chemical Engineering at Bachelor's and Master's level in German and English, the position holder is expected to contribute to the further development of the Faculty's Master's and Bachelor's programs with specialized courses, both in German and English.

In order to achieve these goals, the faculty expects its professors to place their center of life in the Magdeburg region.

The Otto von Guericke University has set itself the strategic goal of significantly increasing the proportion of women. Female scientists are therefore strongly encouraged to apply. Applications from disabled persons will be given priority in the case of equal suitability, ability and professional qualification.
